

Data corrections to Fisheries of the United States, 2011.

After the initial internet release of Fisheries of the United States, 2011, corrections were made to menhaden landings in the Gulf of Mexico and to bluefin tuna landings for the Atlantic Coast.

In the U.S. Domestic Landings, by Species 2010 and 2011 table (pages 1-5), Gulf menhaden landings have been corrected to 1.37 billion pounds and bluefin tuna landings have been corrected to 1.49 million pounds.

Thus, several states totals (page 8) in the Northeast and Louisiana have changed. All changes are due to the bluefin tuna correction with the exception of Louisiana, which was affected by the menhaden. Small changes to the disposition (page 6-7), supply (pages 82, 83, 85), and value added (page 100) tables were also required.
